Discussion Guide

1. What is one thing from the message that God used to encourage, challenge, or grow you?
2. When you think about suffering or hardship in your own life, what has been the hardest part—understanding it, enduring it, or trusting God through it? Share your story.
3. Many people in our culture today feel that God doesn't exist because of suffering and evil. Why do you think this is? What evidence do you see of this sentiment in our culture?
4. When you go through pain or disappointment, what is your natural tendency—pull away from God, ask questions, try to fix it yourself, or lean into others for support? Why do you think that is?
5. Read Romans 3:10–12, 23. What do these verses reveal about humanity and the brokenness of the world? How does understanding sin's impact help explain why suffering exists at all?
6. Read Romans 8:18–22. What stands out to you about creation “groaning” and waiting for restoration? How does this passage help explain the tension between the brokenness we experience now and the hope God promises?
7. Read Romans 8:28. What is the difference between saying “all things are good” and “God works in all things for good”? Why is that distinction important when walking through suffering?
8. If someone asked you this question this week, how would you respond?
9. What is one burden, pain, or struggle you need to honestly bring to God this week instead of carrying it alone? What would trusting Him with that look like in a practical way?
10. Take a few minutes to SOAP through one of the passages referenced in the message today. These are found on the top of the notes page. You may want to include verses before/after the passage listed too. Share your insights with the group.
