Discussion Guide

1. What is one thing from the message that God used to encourage, challenge, or grow you?
2. Have you ever gone through a season where you questioned your purpose or wondered what God was doing in your life? What was that season like for you? Share your story.
3. Our culture often tells us our value and purpose come from success, achievement, money, status, or happiness. Where do you see people most commonly searching for purpose today, and why do you think those things often leave people feeling empty?
4. Read Ephesians 2:8–10 together. What stands out to you about the difference between being saved BY good works and being saved FOR good works? How does that shape the way we think about purpose?
5. Read Micah 6:8 together. Which part of this verse feels most challenging for you right now: acting justly, loving hesed (faithful mercy/kindness), or walking humbly with God? Why?
6. Read Romans 8:15–17. What stands out to you? How does the picture of adoption help us better understand our identity, worth, and relationship with God?
7. Today we realized that purpose is often lived out in ordinary moments of faithful obedience. What are some practical ways we can live out God's purpose in everyday life (live, learn, work, and play) stewarding well our time, talent, and treasure to participate in God's Kingdom and mission?
8. If someone asked you this question this week, how would you respond? Who is one person who needs to know this truth this week? What is your best next step in helping them know it?
9. Take a few minutes to SOAP through one of the passages referenced in the message today. These are found on the top of the notes page. You may want to include verses before/after the passage listed too. Share your insights with the group.
