Discussion Guide

1. What is one thing from the message that God used to encourage, challenge, or grow you?

Why do you think it's difficult to obey when we don't understand the full plan or see immediate reasons for God's direction? What are some common reasons people delay obedience even when they know what the next step is?
6. Read Hebrews 11:7. What stands out to you about Noah responding to "what was not yet seen"? How is biblical faith different from simply hoping things work out?
7. In Genesis 6:18, Noah's obedience affected more than just himself. How have you seen one person's faithfulness positively influence a family, friendship, workplace, or church community?
8. What is one next step of faith God may be asking you to take right now? What is the biggest obstacle standing in the way, and what would it look like to take that step this week?
9. Take a few minutes to SOAP through one of the passages referenced in the message today. These are found on the top of the notes page. You may want to include verses before/after the passage listed too. Share your insights with the group.
