Discussion Guide

1. What is one thing from the message that God used to encourage, challenge, or grow you?
2. Have you ever gone through a season where life felt like it was “on hold”? What made that season particularly difficult? Share your story.
3. Our culture often sees bad things and hardships as evidence of there being no God. Why do you think that is? Share your thoughts.
4. Read Genesis 39:1–2. Joseph went from being his father’s favored son to becoming a slave in Egypt, yet Scripture says, “The Lord was with Joseph.” Why do you think it’s so easy to assume God is distant when life gets hard?
5. Read Genesis 39:8–9. Joseph chose integrity even when no one would have blamed him for compromising. Why is it often difficult to continue doing the right thing when life already feels unfair?
6. Read Genesis 39:21. Joseph ended up in prison after doing the right thing, yet again Scripture says, “The Lord was with Joseph.” How does this challenge the belief that obedience should always lead to easier circumstances?
7. Read Genesis 50:20. Joseph says, “You planned evil against me; God planned it for good.” What is the difference between saying “what happened was good” and saying “God can bring good from what happened”?
8. If you were absolutely confident that God was with you right now, what is one thing you would do differently this week? Share with the group so we can pray for you.
9. Take a few minutes to SOAP through one of the passages referenced in the message today. These are found on the top of the notes page. You may want to include verses before/after the passage listed too. Share your insights with the group.
