Discussion Guide

1. What is one thing from the message that God used to encourage, challenge, or grow you?
2. Think about someone who went out of their way to help you during an important season of your life. What did their willingness to move toward you communicate about their care for you? Share your story.
3. Our culture often encourages people to avoid inconvenience, protect time, and let others meet difficult needs. How does Scripture challenge that way of thinking? Share your thoughts.
4. Read Luke 5:17–20. What obstacles stood between the paralyzed man and Jesus, and what do the actions of the men carrying him reveal about what they believed concerning Jesus?
5. Jesus saw their faith through their actions. What is the difference between simply believing that Jesus changes lives and allowing that belief to move us toward people who need Him?
6. The crowd had gathered to see Jesus, but they became an obstacle keeping someone else from reaching Him. In what ways can followers of Jesus or churches unintentionally make it harder for people to experience Jesus, and what can we do to remove those barriers?
7. Read Luke 5:20–24. Why did Jesus address the man's need for forgiveness before healing his body, and how did the physical healing demonstrate Jesus' authority to forgive sins?
8. The four men could not heal the man, forgive his sins, or transform his life. They simply did what they could and trusted Jesus to do what only He could do. Who is one person God has placed where you live, learn, work, or play whom you can begin praying for and intentionally help take a step toward Jesus? Share with the group so we can pray for you.
9. Take a few minutes to SOAP through the passages referenced in the message today. These are found on the top of the notes page. You may want to include verses before/after the passage listed too. Share your insights with the group.
