6. Read Luke 19:8. What evidence shows that Zacchaeus experienced genuine repentance and heart change? Why is this important?
7. Read Luke 19:9–10 together. What does Jesus mean when He says that He came "to seek and to save the lost"? How would Jesus ultimately accomplish that mission? What hope might this give someone who believes they are too lost to be found?
8. Grace changes our destination and our direction. Where is Jesus currently changing your heart, priorities, relationships, or behavior? Who is one person where you live, learn, work, or play whom you can begin praying for and intentionally help move closer to Jesus this week? Share with the group so we can pray for you.
