6. Read 1 Peter 1:18–21. What did it cost for us to be redeemed from our empty way of life? How should remembering this transform obedience from obligation into gratitude?
7. Read 1 Peter 1:22–25. What connection does Peter make between receiving the truth of the gospel, being born again, and loving one another? Why is sincere love an important sign that God's grace is transforming us?
8. What present direction has God provided that you are struggling to follow? What is your best next step to follow Him this week? Who else do you know that needs to have this understanding too?
