Discussion Guide

1. What is one thing from the message that God used to encourage, challenge, or grow you?
2. Think about a time when rejection, failure, success, disappointment, or someone else's opinion affected how you saw yourself. What made that experience so influential? Share your story.
3. What are some of the things our culture encourages people to use as the foundation of their identity? How does an identity grounded in Jesus challenge those messages? Share your thoughts.
4. Read 1 Peter 2:4–8. What descriptions does Peter use for Jesus? What does the contrast found here teach us about allowing other people's opinions to define us?
5. Read 1 Peter 2:5 and 9–10. What does this reveal about who believers are together? How should remembering that our identity is the result of God's mercy protect us from both insecurity and spiritual pride?
6. Read 1 Peter 2:11–12. How should our identity as God's people shape the way we resist sinful desires, live honorably, and serve others? What might someone who doesn't follow Jesus learn about Him by observing the way you live and the way we engage the world?
7. According to 1 Peter 2:4–10, what is the difference between believing in Jesus and stumbling over Him? How would you explain to someone that Jesus was rejected and crucified for our sin, rose from the dead, and offers mercy, new life, and reconciliation with the Father to everyone who turns from sin and trusts in Him?
8. What false identity have you latched onto that doesn't align with who you are in Jesus? What is your best next step to realign with Scripture? Who else do you know that needs to have this understanding too? Share with the group so we can pray for you.
9. Take a few minutes to SOAP through the passages referenced in the message today. These are found on the top of the notes page. You may want to include verses before/after the passage listed too. Share your insights with the group.
