

BIBLE READING PLAN
MARCH 1-7

March 1 - Colossians 2:6-15

Reflect: Yes, we've read this before, but as we move towards Easter take time today to celebrate all that Jesus accomplished on the cross.

March 2 - Mark 8:31-9:2

Reflect: Jesus told his disciples clearly why He came, and invited them to follow His example of denying himself and taking up His cross. Where are you holding to tightly to your life? What do you need to let go of?

March 3 - Mark 9:2-13

Reflect: The disciples were terrified when they saw the glory of Jesus. Take ten minutes today, sit in silence, and ask Jesus to reveal himself to you.

March 4 - Mark 9:14-29

Reflect: What prayer have you been praying for a long time? Keep asking. Ask God to fill you with faith today. Fast one meal today and cry out to him!

March 5 - Mark 9:30-41

Reflect: Where do you need to become last of all?

March 6 - Mark 9:42-50

Reflect: What needs to be cut out of your life?

March 7 - Colossians 1:15-23

Reflect: Sit in the confidence of your new identity in Christ. You are holy, blameless, above reproach. Celebrate that!

BIBLE READING PLAN
MARCH 8-14

March 8 - Colossians 2:16-23

Reflect: Where have you felt disqualified in your life? Ask the Lord to set you free from those feelings by the truth that you are qualified in Christ.

March 9 - Mark 10:1-12

Reflect: Where does your heart need to be softened today?

March 10 - Mark 10:13-31

Reflect: Faith of a child. How is Jesus asking you to live that out today? What is Jesus asking you to let go of today?

March 11 - Mark 10:32-45

Reflect: Jesus invites us to live differently than the world, and gives a differently picture of greatness. How can you pursue Godly greatness today?

March 12 - Mark 10:46-52

Reflect: He cried out all the more. Set aside time today and prayer. Consider fasting from a meal. During this time simply cry out to Jesus and share your deepest longing with Him.

March 13 - Mark 11:1-14

Reflect: The crowd worshipped Jesus as He entered Jerusalem. Take ten minutes, crank up your favorite worship song, and worship Jesus.

March 14 - Mark 11:15-19

Reflect: Jesus' vision for the church: A house of prayer. How have we made it something different than Jesus' desire?
