**Reflect:** Start every day this week reading this passage. Every day ask the Lord, what do I need to put to death? What do I need to put on?

**March 16 - Mark 11:20-33**

**Reflect:** Read Mark 11:23-25 again. Reflect on your prayer life. Are you holding on to doubt? Where do you need to grow in faith? Who do you need to forgive?

**March 17 - Mark 12:1-12**

**Reflect:** Jesus is the cornerstone. Take some time and ask, Jesus are you truly the cornerstone of my life?

**March 18 - Mark 12:13-27**

**Reflect:** Does government have it's proper place in your life? Have you given too much time and attention to government? To less? Take 5 minutes and focus on Mark 12:24. Ask the Lord to help you know Scripture and the power of God.

**March 19 - Mark 12:28-34**

**Reflect:** Lord, how do you want me to love you with all my heart, soul, mind, and strength today? How do you want to love my neighbor specifically today?

**March 20 - Mark 12:35-40**

**Reflect:** How can you grow in humility today?

**March 21 - Mark 12:41-44**

**Reflect:** How are you to follow the widow's example today?



**Every Day This Week - Colossians 3:18-4:1**

**Reflect:** Start every day this week reading this passage. Ask the Lord, how can my actions today be an act of worship? Lord, remind me today that ultimately I am serving You.

**March 23 - Mark 13:1-22**

**Reflect:** How are you to be on guard today?

**March 24 - Mark 13:23-37**

**Reflect:** As the end gets closer, Jesus command is clear; stay away. Is there any area of your life where you are sleeping?

**March 25 - Mark 14:1-9**

**Reflect:** Think about the woman's example. Her act was beautiful to the Lord. What does it look like for you to give that kind of honor to Jesus today?

**March 26 - Mark 14:12-25**

**Reflect:** Begin your day reading this passage and take time to reflect of Jesus' body given for you. **Begin your day by taking communion, giving thanks to Jesus for His amazing gift.**

**March 27 - Mark 14:26-42**

**Reflect:** Not my will, but your will be done [14:36]. Jesus, where do I need to surrender my will and pick up yours?

**March 28 - Mark 14:43-52**

**Reflect:** One betrayed Jesus. The others all left and fled. Where in your life are you tempted to flee from Jesus? Is there an area of your life you are hiding from Him?
