

BIBLE READING PLAN
FEBRUARY 15-21

February 15 - Colossians 2:6-15

Reflect: Walk in Him [2:6], Alive together with Him [2:13]... Jesus, how am I to do life with you today?

February 16 - Psalm 28

Reflect: Begin your week in worship by blessing or giving thanks to the Lord. Remember a time when God heard your voice and your plea for mercy [28:6].

February 17 - Colossians 2:16-23

Reflect: When have you felt judged or disqualified in your life? How did you feel? Share those feelings with the Lord.

February 18 - Psalm 29

Reflect: The voice of the Lord is powerful. Which quality of His voice stood out to you today? Why?

February 19 - Psalm 30

Reflect: When did the Lord turn your mourning into dancing? Remember His goodness and give Him thanks.

February 20 - Psalm 33

Reflect: The Lord looks down from heaven. Who is the person that the Lord notices? Does this describe you?

February 21 - Psalm 34

Reflect: I sought the Lord and He answered. When did you experience the Lord answering you this week? As you prepare to worship tomorrow, are you supposed to share a testimony of God answering your prayers?

BIBLE READING PLAN
FEBRUARY 22-28

February 22 - Colossians 3:1-11

Reflect: Seek the things that are above. Set your mind on things that are above. What has been occupying your thoughts lately? What earthly things do you need to put off?

February 23 - Psalm 51

Reflect: Confession is powerful. David did it after he sinned. Spend time today confessing your sins to the Lord.

February 24 - Colossians 3:12-17

Reflect: Put on... From the reading today, what do you need to put on? Is there a specific person you need to forgive?

February 25 - Psalm 46

Reflect: In the midst of the craziness of life, what would it look like for you to be still today? Practice being still. Take ten minutes and sit quietly before the Lord.

February 26 - Colossians 3:18-4:1

Reflect: What are the practical implications of the reality that Christ, the hope of glory, lives in you?

February 27 - Psalm 63

Reflect: My soul thirsts for ____? My soul is looking for satisfaction in ____? Does my heart line up with this passage?

February 28 - Psalm 66

Reflect: How have you seen God's awesome deeds or His power this week? How are you to respond when you see God move? Come prepared to worship tomorrow.
