Greetings from Kampala, Uganda!

The team and I have continued our voyage north to the city of Gulu - the place where we provide physical support of the school we built last year. As we started with two rooms, we will double its size to four rooms, and add a kitchen and a toilet. In addition, we will teach kids, provide training for women, and for leaders.

We were very pleased to see the condition of our school in Gulu! The East Canton Church of God Nursery and Primary School now has 120 students, 8 teachers, and 2 cooks! We also have two locations: one - the building we built last year with the two additional rooms built this year and, two - a school property they are renting for the expanding primary school! Praise the Lord!

As I approached this year's mission, I had a big task in regard to leadership development. In past opportunities here, I have provided ongoing biblical training and workshops aimed at developing leaders for the future. Of course, this is critical for any organization - any country! But the difference this time is this: we are developing a plan to introduce a leadership development and credentialing process that has been successful in North America but has not been implemented elsewhere. This is not trivial and is actually quite difficult.



What will make this work, though, is the ingenuity and perseverance of our Ugandan developing leaders. They are so excited about the opportunity to develop as leaders, but also to attain a level of unity that has been elusive until now. Please join me in praying for the plan to be effectively implemented, leaders to be developed, the material to be brought into a Ugandan (African) context, and unity to be achieved for a stronger Church in Uganda! Praise the Lord!



I'm so proud of the team that is here with me. They have put their hearts into this trip in preparation and delivery along with their supporting team: Mike and Gina Conway, Miriam and Britt Hunter, Charlene Moore, my Sherry, and so many more. This is a team sport! I praise God for His continuing work in our ongoing adventures with our Ugandan brothers and sisters.

Tomorrow, Rev. Demetrius Booker from Ohio State Ministries will be bringing God's Word to East Canton. Please come and greet him with a joy-filled East Canton Church of God welcome.
