Also, if you'd like some help in memorizing Scripture, here's a grand program: www.scripturetyper.com. (App also here)

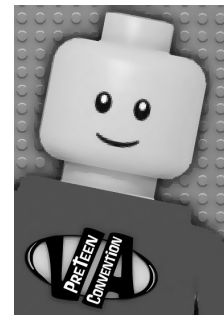


VA Preteen Convention 2015
