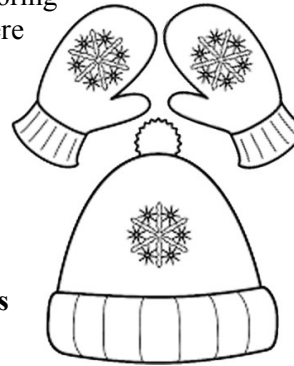

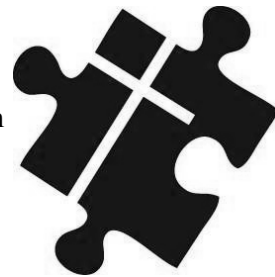
Community Groups
