

When Jesus tells His disciples to love one another, He gives them a new way to live. In John 13:34-35, He says - "A new commandment I give to you, that you love one another: just as I have loved you, you also are to love one another. By this all people will know that you are my disciples, if you have love for one another."

Jesus says, "Just as I have loved you." That means our love is shaped by His love for us. Jesus loved first. He loved patiently; when people failed; when it cost Him something. This is important for our kids to understand. Loving others is not about showing kindness only when it is easy or when we feel like it. It's about choosing to treat people the way Jesus has cared for us. At home, loving one another often looks very ordinary; like forgiving a sibling; sharing without being asked; speaking kindly when we are frustrated; listening instead of reacting. But before our children can love others well, they must first rest in the truth that they are deeply and securely loved by Jesus. When they understand His love for them, their love for others will grow naturally from a heart that has already been filled.
