EURO CONFERENCE TRIP II

An LAC Ministry Team will travel together to a conference center in England October 17-26, 2026. The primary focus of the trip will be serving The Alliance international workers traveling to the conference from various "hard places" and "unreached" people groups. It is a chance to bless them as we all are in community together. The international workers and their children

can be refreshed by gathering together away from their usual isolated work contexts.

The LAC team will serve mostly by caring for the children, ages pre-school through grade 12, while parents are in meetings. Everyone on the team can also minister to the parents by being present with them, listening to and praying for them. Some on the team will lead music, allowing for worship in their heart language.

Anyone interested in being considered to serve on this team will need to fill out an Outreach Trip Application, submit a \$300 deposit (which will be refunded if not chosen), and help in raising funds to meet the cost of the trip. There will be required pre-trip meetings.

LAC NEXT GEN

LAC KIDS | Sometimes, as parents, we are not sure how to teach our kids to pray. There are several tools out there, but one that I have used is the ACTS prayer model.

Adoration: Teaching our children to praise God. Adoration teaches our children to focus on who God is before they focus on what they want from Him. Psalm 145:3 says, *“Great is the Lord, and greatly to be praised, and his greatness is unsearchable.”* This verse reminds us that God is worthy of praise simply because of who He is.

Confession: Teaching our children to come honestly before God. Confession teaches our children that prayer is not about pretending to be perfect. It is about coming honestly to a gracious and forgiving Father. First John 1:9 says, *“If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.”*

Thanksgiving: Teaching our children to recognize the goodness of God. First Thessalonians 5:18 says, *“Give thanks in all circumstances, for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you.”* This verse reminds us that gratitude is not based on how easy the day has been. It is a response to God’s faithfulness in all things.

Supplication: Teaching our children to bring our needs to God. Philippians 4:6 says, *“Do not be anxious about anything, but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known to God.”* This verse shows us that God invites His people to bring every concern to Him in prayer.

I am learning that our children do not need us to be prayer experts. They need us to be present and intentional. And I think the ACTS prayer method is one helpful tool we can use to get started!"
