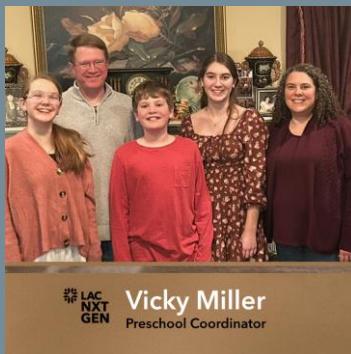
week is simply an invitation to one honest question: *Jesus, what do you want from me?*

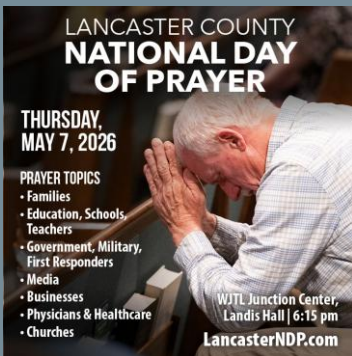
You are encouraged to participate in the upcoming PA Primary Election on May 19th, when voters help shape the choices available in the November General Election.

LAC NEXT GEN

Here's something that I think many of us, including myself, need to be reminded of regularly: the Gospel isn't just the starting line of the Christian life. It's the fuel for the entire race.

Consider how easy it is to slip into a performance mindset as a Christian, and especially as a Christian parent. We tell ourselves things like, "I need to read my Bible more," "I need to pray harder," "I need to be a better example for my kids." And while those things aren't bad in themselves, when they're driven by guilt or a desire to earn God's approval, we've lost the point. We've forgotten what the Gospel actually says about us.

The Gospel tells us that God's love for us is not based on our performance. It is based on what Jesus has already done. Romans 8:1 says, "There is therefore now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus." That's not a reward for doing well. That's simply the reality for everyone who has placed their faith in Jesus. You are fully loved, fully forgiven, and fully accepted, right now, today, even on your worst parenting day.

Praise God for His unrelenting love for us.
