LAC NEXT GEN

Deuteronomy 6:4-7 *"Hear, O Israel: The LORD our God, the LORD is one. You shall love the LORD your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your might. And these words that I command you today shall be on your heart. You shall teach them diligently to your children, and shall talk to them when you sit in your house, and when you walk by the way, and when you lie down, and when you rise."*

One of the greatest privileges God gives parents is the opportunity to teach their kids what it means to love Him. This passage points out something important about discipleship in the home: it typically happens in the ordinary moments. Sure, our kids will have mountain-top experiences, like church camping or a retreat, where God works in new ways. But spiritual growth usually happens in the simple moments of family life, like eating together, driving to school, family devotions, and learning to forgive each other. From my experience, God does some of His best work when we are on a steady diet of biblical truth and committed to spiritual growth.

My encouragement to you today is this: You have what it takes to point your kids to Jesus! God has equipped you with the spiritual gifts needed to lead your household. Take it one step at a time, and be ready to capitalize on the little moments to show them what it means to follow Jesus with all your heart, soul, mind, and strength.
