CHURCH LEADERSHIP TEAM SHOUT-OUT



LAC NEXT GENERATION

For many of us, the summer flew by, and we are in the midst of the back-to-school whirlwind. If you are a little like me and somewhere in between being thankful for change, but aware of the challenges, I'd like to give you two things to be aware of as you surrender this school year to Jesus...

- Be present. Your kids need you to be present with them. In Mark, Jesus calls the disciples to first be with them before developing them to do what they are supposed to do. Value presence over production.
- Listen well. With so many tasks, questions, and responsibilities as parents, we can often react before truly understanding. In John 4, Jesus listens to the woman at the well, even though he already knew what she needed, wanted, and the gap between. When we listen, we communicate value and belonging to those speaking.

Presence and listening are two of the simplest ways to demonstrate Jesus to your kids, especially at the beginning of the school year. We're praying for each of you and Jesus' favor over this school season.
