
CHILD DEDICATION

LAC NEXT GENERATION

A month into the school year, it's probably safe to say that we have settled into new routines, assignments, and practices. In the midst of it all, our kids may or may not need help with their homework, but they definitely need our steady presence and spiritual leadership.

To make this happen, I want to encourage you to stay focused on your own relationship with Jesus as you seek to lead your family well. In Colossians 2:6-7, Paul writes - "Therefore, as you received Christ Jesus the Lord, so walk in him, rooted and built up in him and

established in the faith, just as you were taught, abounding in thanksgiving."

Parents, when we stay rooted in Jesus, we aren't tossed around by the pressures of schedules and family stress. Our connection to Jesus gives us the strength needed to endure the storms that are bound to come in a typical school year. Our rootedness in Jesus brings a steadiness to our homes that our kids desperately need.

Here are 2 simple ways to stay rooted starting today:

- Connect to Jesus daily through prayer and Scripture. Whether you have 5 minutes or 30 minutes to spend reading and praying, that time will never be wasted. It's a way for you to stay connected and grounded in God.
- 2. Talk to other Jesus-loving parents. We all need support. We all need help. Build some relationships with other parents who can encourage you along in your parenting journey. Sometimes, just talking about the pressures of parenting can bring you the hope you need to stay strong when things get difficult.
