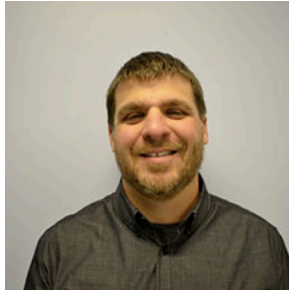


REV. JOSEPH BURCHILL
