

# LAC Primetimers | Spring Bus Trip

Warmer weather is on its way and this will set the pace for a wonderful day of exploring Pennsylvania. Participants will board the motor coach at the church as we head off to Pennsbury Manor, the colonial estate of William Penn, founder and proprietor of the Colony of Pennsylvania, who lived there from 1699 to 1701. He left it and returned to England in 1701. Following his departure and financial woes, the estate fell into numerous hands and disrepair. Restoration was completed in 1939. The 43-acre estate has nine buildings to explore.



During our coach journey to the Mercer Museum in Doylestown, we will enjoy a special box lunch enroute. The Mercer Museum is a six-story concrete castle designed by Henry Mercer (1856-1930) and completed in 1916. It is one of Bucks County's premier cultural attractions and a Smithsonian affiliate.

The museum features local and national traveling exhibits, as well a collection of over 17,000 pre-Industrial tools and is one of the world's most comprehensive portraits of pre-Industrial American material culture.

The museum also features a research library that is a center for local history related to Bucks County and the surrounding region, with its roots dating back to the founding of the Bucks County Historical Society in 1880.



Peddler's Village is a storybook village with charming colonial-style buildings and award-winning gardens. For more than 60 years, visitors have followed the winding brick pathways to experience exceptional dining and explore the best of Bucks County shopping. You'll have this free time to walk through the village and enjoy the many shops and the restaurant options for dinner.

Make sure to check out the 7th Annual PEEPS® in the Village. The colorful display will include more than 100 creations of wall art, dioramas, and sculpture, featuring the popular Pennsylvania-made bunnies and chicks.

*NOTE: Be prepared for a full day of walking, with the bus providing transport between stops.*
