OVERVIEW

Prayer is the lifeblood of LAC. We express our hope and dependency on God through expectant prayer. We also have dedicated times for prayer as an entire church, when we cancel all other events and humble ourselves before God. We have weekly groups that meet on Wednesday evening and Sunday mornings to pray, as well as smaller groups that meet in homes with the primary focus being prayer.

We have a system of communication of prayer concerns that is distributed by a Facebook page, text alerts, email notifications, and a weekly list of prayer concerns distributed every Wednesday. Our dependence upon God is expressed most vividly in our practice of prayer.
