CORE LIFE PATHWAY

About the Core Life Pathway

The Core Life Pathway at LAC is an intentional response to Jesus's invitation to "Follow." It's a relational journey with the ultimate goal of being a disciple of Jesus. Our definition of a disciple is: Someone who is following Jesus, being changed by Him, and committed to His mission.

The name "Core Life Pathway" reflects our focus on getting to the core of what we believe - our core identity in Christ and LAC's Core Values of being Present, Surrendered, and Others Focused. This discipleship pathway helps us move past surface-level faith to build life outward from that essential center - Jesus in us. For those on the Pathway, these Core Values would be increasingly visible. Discipleship is not optional (Matthew 28:19-20). Discipleship is a journey, not a momentary decision. Stepping onto the Core Life Pathway is a fulfillment of our LAC mission: leading people to Jesus and His life-transforming work, locally and around the world.

This Core Life Pathway is a map to guide individuals from areas of non-belief toward becoming mature, mission-focused disciples who understand the gospel and integrate it into every aspect of their lives. You might think of it as a sequential journey of apprenticeship with Jesus, as seen in passages like John 1:36-42 and Matthew 4:18-22.

Along the way, we have designed "tools" to help travelers. The goal is transformation. Jesus changes us and then puts us in motion to minister to others in ways only we can.

The Pathway needs to be experienced uniquely by everyone as they respond to the work of the Holy Spirit around specific areas of need, growth, and healing (John 21:19-21). It also needs to be experienced relationally, as we walk together with 3-4 others on the journey where we help care of each other's souls. This can happen in a number of ways, such as being part of a Core Life Group, engaging in Core Life Conversations, or by being part of weekly Core Life rhythms as part of a loving community together on mission. The Pathway has many onramps for entry and offers a variety of "vehicles" to travel in as we move toward sanctification. This booklet and our website give more details.

Next Gen exists to create a gospel-centered environment that engages the next generation and their families to serve, equip, and reach people in the life-transforming work of Jesus.

We believe Jesus accomplishes this through us by...

- Providing a safe environment for the next generation to engage in gospel-centered biblical teaching
- Equipping healthy, Jesus following leaders through development and training
- Creating fun and engaging interaction with caring adults
- Developing and providing resources that empower parents to disciple their families

Weekly Ministry Rhythms

Our Next Gen gatherings focus on creating a gospel-centered, safe environment. Our goal is to create opportunities for the next generation to engage in age-appropriate, gospel-centered lessons, fun activities, and positive interactions with caring adults. This environment results in empowering kids with gospel-centered truth they can live out practically.

Each minor participating in ministry events, activities, and classes must be checked in for safety purposes. Nursery-grade 4 children are checked in by their parents or guardians and provided with a guardian sticker to be used for pick-up. Grades 5-12 will be checked in the participating environment. Parents of Nursery-24 months are issued a pager when their child is dropped off.

Volunteers and Staff

Our volunteers and staff serve on a regular basis and have been vetted by a thorough screening process that includes a questionnaire, interview, and PA Child Safety Clearances. Additionally, volunteers are provided with ongoing opportunities for development and training to be well equipped for serving the next generation.



Nursery-24 months childcare is provided on Sunday mornings from 9:45-10:30AM, and 11AM-12PM in Section E of our building.

- Room E4 for children dropped off
- Room E6 for nursing mothers

LAC Preschool ministry is provided on Sunday mornings 9:45AM-12PM in Section E. Children will enjoy an age-appropriate, gospel-centered lesson, fun activities, snacks, and sing-along worship which takes place between Life Conversations (10:30-11AM) and children's church.

- Room E3 for children 2-3 years old
- Room E5 for children 4-5 years old
- Room E7 for children 2-5 years old (10:30-11AM sing-along)

LAC KIDS (CONTINUED)

Grades K-4 is offered Sunday mornings 9:45-10:30AM in LL5 and 11AM-12PM in LL1. Additionally ministry is offered on Wednesday nights 6:30-8PM in LL1. When students arrive, free play activities are available for the first few minutes, allowing caring adults to develop relationships with the kids and for the kids to interact with one another. Next, we gather for our lesson and discuss how Jesus is relevant to our lives and how we can live out the Gospel within a biblical context. Lessons often include activities that strengthen understanding and provide opportunities for relationship building. Our time together concludes with groups praying for each other. As time allows, students are then provided with free play before being picked up by their parents.

Sundays (Saddleback Kids Curriculum)

9:45-10:30AM focuses on Gospel Elements.

11AM-12PM focuses on Jesus' transformational work in scripture.

Wednesdays

6:30-8PM focuses on kids growing deeper in their walk with Jesus.



Early Student is offered Sunday mornings from 9:45-10:30AM (grades 5-7) and Wednesday nights from 6:30-8PM (grades 5-6) in the lower level of our building. In each environment, students are provided with instruction and guidance in a gospel-centered relational approach through scripture that relies on the transformational work of Jesus.

Sundays 9:45-10:30AM (Grades 5-7). Smaller gatherings, biblically-based, Jesus-centered discussions that include fun interaction.

Wednesdays 6:30-8PM (Grades 5-6). Larger gathering that includes games, biblically-based gospel-centered interactive teaching, and small group engagement.

Student Ministries is offered Sunday mornings 9:45-10:30AM (Grades 8-12) and Wednesday nights from 6:30-8PM (Grades 7-12) in the lower level of the building. Students are provided with instruction and guidance in a gospel-centered relational approach that relies on the transformational work of Jesus.

Sundays 9:45-10:30AM (Grades 8-12). Smaller gatherings, biblically-based, Jesus-centered discussions that include opportunities for practical engagement.

Wednesdays 6:30-8PM (Grades 7-12). Larger gatherings that include games and activities, biblically-based gospel-centered practical teaching, and age-appropriate small group interaction.
