2020 is over! As we enter into 2021, we certainly don't have the coronavirus taken out completely, but with news of the vaccine, we know that its days are numbered! If you haven't already, stop for a moment and give praise to God for this good news. Government leaders are quick to praise the record-breaking effort of scientists around the world to produce a vaccine, but we all know that it was God at work through human hands and intellects formed by His perfect will. We continue to pray that God would bring the pandemic to a swift end sometime this year, and that crowds around the world would give him praise for providing such relief.

On more of a local level, we have some things to be excited about in 2021 right here at FBC Grandview. For years now, we have been considering different options for our church to prepare for the continued growth in our community. If you live in the Grandview area, you are keenly aware that people are moving here in droves. Despite the difficulty of this past year, growth continued. As the vaccine is distributed and COVID concerns lessen in our area, we should expect the population growth in Grandview and the surrounding countryside to pick up pace even more. This will happen whether we want it to or not. The question is, will our church be ready for the growth?

FBC Grandview is called by God to make as many disciples as possible. This church has done so for over 160 years now, and we should continue to lead the way in our area as a mission-minded congregation. This church has been forward thinking through its history which has enabled us to continue to have a divine impact in our community. The time for forward thinking is once again upon us. One project the deacon body has been and is still considering for the near future of our church is the construction of a family life center: a building with a gym, education space, and worship space among other things. The deacon body also believes that our church will likely face the need to construct an entire new campus within the next 10 to 20 years. One of the main obstacles to both of these construction plans is a lack of space on our current property. Thankfully, we believe that God has provided a solution to that problem.

The deacon body will be calling a special called church conference on Sunday, January 10th at the conclusion of both of our morning worship services. In the conference, the deacons will present a recommendation for the church to purchase 15 acres

of land from Grandview Historical Properties. These 15 acres are situated perfectly to meet our needs. This new property will connect into a small piece of undeveloped property that we currently own to the northeast of our main campus across Inez Hardy Way. The new property continues eastward behind the Church of Christ and then wraps around to find frontage on East Criner Street between the Church of Christ and the Shell station. The total cost for these 15 acres is \$400,000. We certainly understand that this is a large sum of money, but we believe this purchase will be a key part of helping position FBC Grandview to continue to grow and reach our community with Jesus for years to come. Also, our budget and finance committee will be meeting between now and January 10th to put together a plan to purchase this property with funds that we already possess, meaning there will be no need to borrow funds.

Once the property is acquired, we will begin developing, in earnest, a plan to start building a family life center that will help us minister to the needs of our community. Likewise, we will continue to look at our long-range goal of an entire new facility in the coming years. Acquiring the 15 acres described above, however, is the first step in this process. I believe that God has big plans for this church. I see FBC Grandview making sure that our community knows they're loved by Jesus and His church for at least another 160 years. Join us in the special called conference on January 10th, and vote in the affirmative to help us realize the plans that God has for us!

One of the apostle Paul's companions in ministry, Barnabas, had a name that suited him to a tee. I'm told "Barnabas" is literally translated "son of encouragement." First Baptist Church, Grandview, might just as easily be named "Barnabas Baptist Church." You have been godly encouragers to me each day since my surgery. I look forward to rejoining you in worship and enjoying your kind encouragement in person. "THANK YOU!" again for proving to be the church we have known you to be these past 15 years. I LOVE YOU!


