Love Like Jesus

"Anyone who does not love, does not know God, because God is love." – 1st John 4:8

Our family enjoys Valentine's Day, and not just because we like giving and receiving gifts. We appreciate Valentine's Day because it's one of the only holidays that can just be about us. Don't get me wrong, we love celebrating Christmas with our families and church, and we love events like our Fall Festival on or around Halloween. With Valentine's though, there's no extra events, no travel, nothing besides celebrating one another to make the day special. Hopefully, you're already planning how to make the event meaningful for the special people in your life.

As we think about Valentine's Day, our mind of course is drawn to love. This is a good opportunity for us to recenter our hearts and minds not on the whims of our culture, but on the truth of God's Word. Our culture often paints the Church of Jesus Christ as a tired, stale religion devoid of any passion or excitement. Then, the world and the Enemy at work behind the scenes try to come in and sell us their own version of love. They present a version of love that appears fun and exciting, but

ultimately revolves around our own selfish desires. This is especially true of romantic love. In our culture romantic love looks like consequence free and hypersexual love affairs that are less based on selflessly serving another person and more based on our fleshly urges.

While sexual love is certainly a part of a healthy Christian marriage, one of our jobs as Christians is to remind our world that true love, the love of Christ, is SO MUCH MORE! If anybody in the world ought to be a person of passionate love, it is the Christ follower. Our story is one centered on love. The protagonist of our story creates humanity to have perfect loving fellowship with them, but humanity spurns that love. Then, instead of turning His back on humanity, our protagonist spends the rest of the story pursuing the very humanity that rejected His love in the first place! Even as humanity chases after other lovers that only love in counterfeit ways, our loving protagonist continues to issue His call to return to His love. Finally, and perfectly according to plan, our protagonist does what no one else is willing to do, and sacrifices Himself for His creation... He sacrifices Himself for us. He didn't have to. He had done nothing wrong. As a matter of fact, He had lived the perfect life. Why take a punishment that wasn't His? Why die for people who, by their actions, declare themselves His enemy?
