Why We Go

"And Jesus came and said to them, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you always, to the end of the age." —Matthew 28:19-20

Jesus' final words before His ascension are some of the most familiar in all of Scripture: Most of us have heard them so often that they risk becoming background noise in our Christian vocabulary. We know them. We quote them. We nod our heads in agreement with them. Yet if we are honest, we often struggle to live them out with the urgency and intentionality they deserve.

Evangelism is one of those words that can feel intimidating. For some, it brings to mind uncomfortable conversations, fear of rejection, or the worry of saying the wrong thing. For others, it feels like something meant for pastors, missionaries, or particularly bold believers. But Jesus never limited His command to a select group of professionals. The call to share the Gospel is given to every follower of Christ. This February, our church will once again, along with other local churches, host Disciple Now, an event specifically designed to share the Gospel with junior high and high school students. This weekend is more than a retreat. It is more than games, worship music, and small groups. It is an intentional effort to place students face-to-face with the truth of who Jesus is and what He has done for them. Why do we make such a big deal about this? Because the Gospel changes lives. Scripture tells us in Romans 1:16 that the Gospel "is the power of God for salvation to everyone who believes." Not our clever arguments. Not our emotional stories. Not our programs or personalities. The Gospel itself is the power. It is the simple and profound message that God created us, we sinned against Him, Jesus died and rose again to save us, and through faith in Him we are made new.

You see, Disciple Now is not only about students. It is about all of us. Every year, this event requires prayer, preparation, and participation from the whole church body. Some of you will open your homes. Some will cook meals. Some will lead small groups. Some will pray quietly and faithfully behind the scenes. In many ways, Disciple Now becomes a living picture of what evangelism looks like when the church works together. There is something powerful when a church rallies around the mission of sharing the Gospel. Students notice it. Guests notice it. And most importantly, God honors it.

Perhaps the most important question for us this month is a simple one: Do we still believe the Gospel is worth sharing? It is easy to become comfortable. Easy to assume that everyone who needs Jesus will somehow find Him without our involvement. Easy to forget that many of the people around us have never truly heard the message of grace and forgiveness in a personal way. Evangelism is not an abstract idea. It has names and faces. It can look like a student hearing that God loves them for the first time at DNow, and it can look like you finally taking the risk to share the gospel with a coworker. I want to encourage you to do two things in light of our upcoming DNow. First, pray. Pray for the students who will attend DNow. Pray for open hearts. Pray for leaders and volunteers. Pray that the Holy Spirit would do what only He can do.

Also, remember that Disciple Now is a reminder of our everyday calling. The weekend will end, but the mission does not. Evangelism is not confined to one event. It is woven into our lives as followers of Jesus — at school, at work, in our families, and in our community. Jesus came "to seek and to save the lost" (Luke 19:10). When we share the Gospel, we are simply joining Him in what He is already doing. So let us be a church that goes. Goes in prayer. Goes in love. Goes in faith. And goes with confidence that the message we carry is the greatest news the world has ever known.
