Church Family,

I shared in my last article about how the seasons reflect the transformation that takes place in our lives. It is not a coincidence that we celebrate Easter, or Resurrection Sunday, at the start of the season of renewal. Christ came to Earth as the perfect spotless Lamb of God to wash away our sins. When my oldest son, Weston, began asking questions about the Bible and stories he had heard, I remember him equating Easter to Christ's death on the cross. It's the symbol that is most recognizable and that we often use during the Easter holiday—the three wooden crosses. However, that was only the beginning. The resurrection of Jesus Christ is the reason we get to celebrate and hope for the future. "He saved us, through the washing of rebirth and renewal of the Holy Spirit," Titus 3:5. Had Christ not risen from the dead and been revived, we would not have eternal life in Him. God might not call us to death and resurrection, but you can be sure He will call us to new life in Him and He will do it over and over again until the day He calls us home.

When I personally think about the spring season, the word renew often comes to mind. Renew is defined by the Merriam-Webster Dictionary as: to make like new or to make new spiritually. When the bitter-cold and barren winter months reflect what is in our hearts and minds, we have this hope that God can and will renew us like He does each spring. Isaiah 40:31 tells us, "but those who hope in the Lord will renew their strength. They will soar on wings like eagles; they will run and not grow weary, they will walk and not be faint." Our power and strength has limitations. We will become tired mentally, physically, and spiritually. But church family, God's strength and power will NEVER diminish or run out. He is never too tired to help us when we have run ourselves ragged trying to do everything in our own power. Remember that God will take care of us

when we ask and allow Him complete control of our lives.


Church family, what might God be trying to restore in your life? What areas do you need renewal and revival. Psalm 51:10 tells us that we need only ask. "Create in me a pure heart, O God, and renew a steadfast spirit within me." God desires for us to ask Him and allow Him to work in our hearts and minds, but don't be surprised if it looks completely different than you were expecting. Is He calling you out of your comfort zone to serve in an area you would rather not? Is He calling you to give up something precious to you? Is He asking you to take something on that seems daunting? Pray. Ask. Listen. God will reveal His will to us when we quiet our minds and listen for His still small voice.

Lastly, I leave you with this verse from 2 Corinthians 4:16, that it may encourage anyone who reads it.

"Therefore we do not lose heart. Though outwardly we are wasting away, yet inwardly we are being renewed day by day."
