Easter Celebration

"Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ! According to his great mercy, he has caused us to be born again to a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead." –1 Peter 1:3

I love the month of April. Spring is in full bloom. Summer is near on the horizon, and there's my birthday... (let's not discuss it being number 40). Some of my favorite April memories, however, revolve around the Easter holiday. The church I grew up in was small, but we did Easter right. We would celebrate the whole point of the story that morning in Sunday School and worship, and then we would go home, grab a guick bite to eat, change out of our Sunday best (which since it was Easter was usually a new dress shirt), and then head back out for the big Easter Egg hunt. The hunt took place on my grandfather's property that had a creek running through it. The whole congregation had to literally drive through a cotton field to get there. Several adults went early to hide the eggs, and there was always at least one "prize egg." This egg was usually filled with a \$10 bill, which seemed like a fortune as a kid. The egg could be way up in a tree, buried a few feet underground, or even covered by a dried-up cow patty. Then after that, we would drive back through the cotton field and to the church for a game of pick-up baseball which some of us took way too seriously (I once watched our pastor plow through my Dad because he was standing in the base path in front of first base) followed up by eating some often-overcooked hamburgers for supper. My great uncle and "grill master" was a fan of well-done meat evidently. There was lots of fun, laughter, and celebration.

Isn't that the way it should be for all God's children in light of the resurrection? Easter is God's answer to our sin and the death our sin has wrought. Easter is a bright light shining in a dark world, promising us that there is something more than this life. Even though we all die, Easter reminds us that, one day, death itself will die once and for all. Easter is our hope and joy. Jesus is alive! Your sins are destroyed! Death is overcome! Eternity, for those of us who place our faith in Jesus, is a neverending celebration of the victory Christ wrought through His resurrection. This is what we will celebrate this Easter holiday at FBC Grandview, and we have big plans for this Easter weekend!

First, and most importantly, we will be celebrating the story of the resurrection in both worship services on Easter Sunday April 9^{th} at 8:30AM and 11:00AM. We encourage you to invite

family, friends, and neighbors to hear about how the good news of Jesus Christ's resurrection is proof that Jesus loves them and His church does too. We will also celebrate the story of the resurrection in Sunday School at 9:45AM for all ages. Before or after Sunday School, we invite you to join us in the fellowship hall for an Easter brunch that will be served from 9:00AM to 10:30AM. And if you want to join us for a special sunrise service, we will gather with other area churches at Meinen Lake at 7AM to sing and read Scripture as the sun (and Son) rises. There will also be donuts and coffee there!

This year, we'll also be hosting our own Easter Egg hunt and celebration on Saturday April 8th. From 3PM to 5PM we will gather at Zebra Stadium for our first annual "Easter in the View". There will be inflatables set up for the kids, and we will have both Entwined Grounds and Shiver Shack on site. Then at 3:30PM we will have a giant Easter Egg hunt on the football field for kids ages babies through 5th grade, divided up into three age groups. There will be candy of course, but there will also be prizes for the kids. And if you participate in a special family activity, you'll have your choice of either a free drink from Entwined Grounds or a snow cone! This should be a blast, and we hope to see everyone there. Leading up to the event, we're going to need lots and lots of Easter eggs though. If you would like to donate, please bring PRE-FILLED EGGS ONLY with you to any church service and place them in one of the many bins we'll have set up throughout our campus.

We're hoping to make some memories, share some laughs, and simply have a blast together this Easter weekend. What better reason is there to celebrate than the fact that our Savior has defeated sin and death for our sake! Happy Easter! And, oh yeah, one last thing. We are also planning to make a very important and exciting announcement about the future of FBC Grandview during both worship services on Easter Sunday. It's gonna be a fun weekend.
