Making Room

"In him you also are being built together into a dwelling place for God by the Spirit." — Ephesians 2:22

I'm sitting at my desk writing this on the Tuesday following Easter Sunday, and I gotta tell you, I am super excited about what God is doing in and through FBC Grandview. We had a great Easter weekend, starting with a fun and well attended volleyball tournament hosted by our Student Ministry. Then we had a great turnout at our first ever "Easter in the View" event. Thank you all so much for the eggs you turned in. We filled Zebra stadium with almost 4,000 eggs when all was said and done, and they still went quickly! Also, a huge thanks to everyone who volunteered to make that event happen. Even though I'm always worn out after those kinds of events, I always love doing them here at FBC because so many of you show up to make it happen. The teamwork I witnessed for both Saturday and Sunday during Easter weekend was awesome. Whether you were managing a bounce house full of little ones, preparing an awesome brunch for our church family, volunteering for our welcome team, or any other number of roles, thank you so much for your work. It did not go unrewarded. Between our two Easter Sunday services, we ended up getting to share the Gospel story and the true power of the resurrection with at least 368 people! God is definitely up to something!

One of things that I believe God is up to is our new "Making Room" building campaign. For years now, our leadership has been discussing the possibility of expansion to our campus. We went through several versions of plans, until God finally began to bring those plans together. We were able to purchase (debt free) a 15 acre piece of land that joined with land we already owned across the street from our current campus. This purchase helped us to think bigger picture about expansion. The result is a master plan that we've put together that will likely be several years in the making. This plan involves a new sanctuary, office space, education space, etc. The first phase of the plan, however, is our new Family Life Center.

The Family Life Center will include a gym space that will double as a new Fellowship Hall. It will have a new kitchen and a portable stage in it for a variety of events. We'll also have a few classrooms so that it can be useful for the weekly ministries of our church. We're also including full bathrooms, complete with showers so that we can serve as an emergency center if the need arises. With this new space we want to make room for

what God is doing through FBC Grandview.

We want to make room for our growing student and children's ministries. We want to make room for our young, middle, and senior adult ministries as well. We also want to make more room to serve our community by providing a space for our community to gather. We want to communicate to Grandview that FBC is a people who want everyone in Grandview to know they are loved by Jesus and His Church. Above all, we want to make room for the movement of God. We want to make room for the lost to come to Him, and for the found to dive deeper in Him. Grandview is changing, and we believe God wants to use that change to grow His church. This is exciting stuff!

Just like our Easter celebrations though, none of this happens unless it is an entire church effort. This means that the members of FBC Grandview are going to have to be willing to spend their time and money on pursuing this vision. We need you to be in prayer in the coming days to consider how God might be calling you to financially support this endeavor. I HATE asking for money, but I'm doing it right now anyway. That's how much I believe in this project. I hope that you can see this vision, and I hope that you are excited about the potential. Above all, I hope that you're ready to make room in your own life for what God is doing and how you might be a part of His ministry in Grandview and beyond.

Hello church fam,

Summer is upon us! You know what that means...right...!! It means camp is right around the corner!!! In honor of it

being close to camp season, here are 4 reasons to send your student to camp!

Spiritual Growth—It has been said that a week at summer camp is a like a whole year of Sunday School. Seeing students singing to the Lord, watching the Bible come alive before your eyes...all these things spur students on to growing spiritually. Some will respond to Christ's offer of forgiveness for the first time and others will deepen their relationship with Jesus, maybe even starting a habit of their own daily quiet time. Spiritual growth is the number one benefit of camp.

Independence—Campers have spending money and generally it needs to last them the entire week. Some campers spend the majority of their money early in the week at the general store leaving them little or no money for a snack later in the week. Watching your friend eat a Snickers bar and down a Gatorade while you're out of money, talk about a life lesson! Have you ever seen a 13-year-old confronted with six different options for how to spend their afternoon? A strong benefit of camp is gained independence.

Interdependence—Living in the temporary community of a cabin with 14 other students as well as a camp with another 500 campers of varying ages is powerful. Relying on that staffer to hold a rope as you climb up 35 feet so you can be encouraged to slide off into the abyss of the zip line by that other staffer waiting for you at the top can be frightening. God created us for community. Camp delivers just that.

Time Away from the everyday—Come on! Seriously, what pressures are students facing? They aren't paying the mortgage, fixing the car, or solving problems at work. True enough, but has there ever been a time in history where information is so freely available? That same student who isn't helping with the utility bill is hearing about North Korea, mass shootings and hurricanes. Our kids these days are too plugged in. They are growing up too fast. Students today need camp more than ever. They need a week or more to get unplugged from their devices. They need to have fun. They need to laugh. They need to be challenged with a message not delivered in a 2-minute video. They need to run, jump and scream. They need to sing. Teens need a break from the everyday. Once again, camp is just the place for them.

For those interested in sending your student to camp, please act now, we only have 40 spots open. I also have a camp packet available in the youth room, that tells you all you need to know about camp. Please begin praying for all our summer endeavors, here at FBC!
