Community Matters More Than You Know

“And let us consider how to stir up one another to love and good works, not neglecting to meet together, as is the habit of some, but encouraging one another, and all the more as you see the

September often feels like the month when life settles into its real rhythm. The first-day photos are on the fridge, the calendars are filling up, and the new school year is no longer new.

In the middle of that settling, something quieter but just as important is happening: people decide whether they will simply attend church or actually belong to the church.

A Sunday morning service is a gift. It is not the whole life of the church. The mission of FBC Grandview - that every man, woman, and child in our community would know they are loved by Jesus and His Church - does not happen only from a pew.

It happens in rooms where people open the Bible together, in homes where burdens are shared, on Wednesday nights when questions get honest, and in ministries where ordinary believers use their gifts so others can encounter Christ. Isolation is easy. Intentional community is how the gospel takes root.

That is why we are setting aside both worship services on Mission Fair Sunday. During both our 8:30 and 11:00 gatherings, you will have a chance to walk through opportunities to connect and to serve. Sunday school classes, Wednesday night studies, and home groups will be represented so you can meet leaders, hear what they are studying, and consider where you might grow. Tables will also

highlight places to serve across the ministries of our church - kids, students, worship, hospitality, missions, and more. No one will pressure you. The goal is simple: help you take a next step instead of wondering where you fit. The beauty of this kind of Sunday is that it does not require you to have it all figured out. It only requires a willing heart. Some of you need a smaller circle after a season of standing on the edges. Some of you have gifts the church needs and have not yet been asked. Some of you are new and simply need a face and a name. Some of you have been here a long time and it is time to move from receiving to investing. All of those next steps matter. The Holy Spirit uses ordinary conversations, consistent presence, and shared ministry to steady people in the grace of Jesus.

I want to challenge each of us to treat Mission Fair as more than an announcement. Come ready to look, to ask, and to pray. Invite someone who has been visiting. If you already have a group, bring a friend who does not. If you already serve, help someone else find their place. And if you have been waiting for a clear invitation, this is it.

The fall will be busy. It always is. But busy is not the same as connected, and connected is how lives are changed. Let's make FBC Grandview a place where people do not just hear the gospel on Sunday morning, but live it out in classes, homes, and ministries the rest of the week.

May we be known as a church where no one has to walk alone, every gift is needed, and the love of Jesus is made visible in the ordinary days of September and beyond.

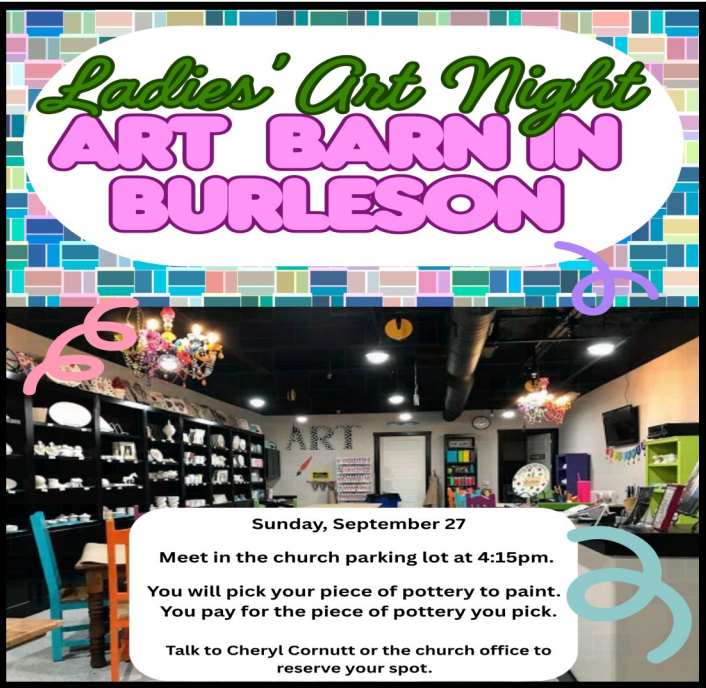
