## **Nursery Worker Job Description**

**SUMMARY OF DUTIES:** Provide a safe, nurturing, teaching environment for children, from birth through age five or completion of Kindergarten, during church-related functions.

**RESPONSIBILITIES:** The requirements listed below are representative of the knowledge, skill, and/or ability required. To perform this job successfully, an individual must be able to perform the following duties satisfactorily:

- Help provide and maintain a Christian environment in which the children may grow physically, emotionally, mentally, socially, and spiritually.
- Become acquainted with each child and aware of his/her needs.
- Give each child the attention needed to ensure his/her best welfare. (This relates to eating, toileting, sleeping, playing, working, health care, safety, etc.)
- Be familiar with and follow the established personnel policies and procedures.
- Work according to the schedule outlined by the Coordinator.
- All Nursery Workers will be expected to follow the Church Policy and Children's Ministry Policy guidelines.

**SPECIAL CONDITIONS:** This position is classified as part-time support staff and does not include vacation, sick leave, or other benefits afforded to full-time personnel. This position reports to the Nursery Coordinator and is supervised by the Children's Minister.
