

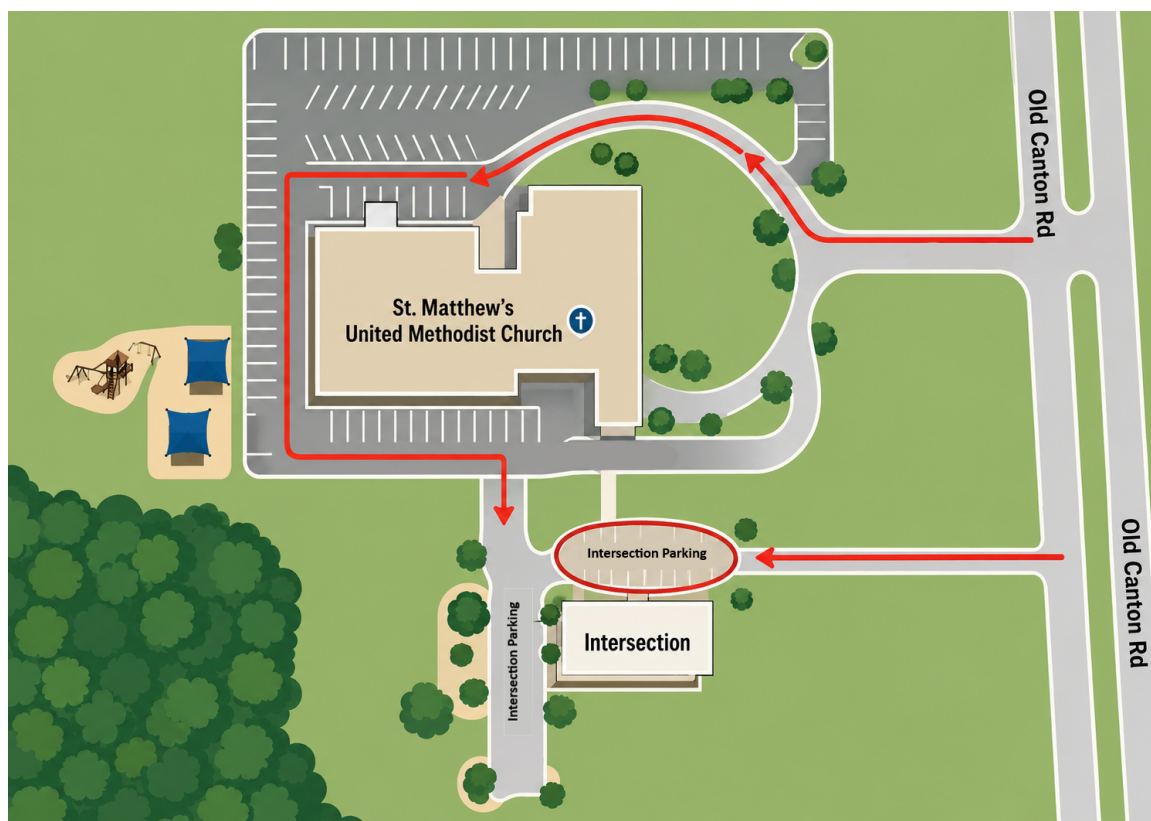


What to Expect at Intersection Worship

We're excited you're thinking about joining us! Whether you've been in church your whole life or this is your first time in a long time, we want you to feel at home. Here are a few things you can expect when you visit.

Where do I park?

Using the provided parking map, look for the spaces marked "Intersection Parking." Our parking team will be happy to help you if you have any questions when you arrive.



What should I wear?

Come as you are! You'll see everything from blue jeans and T-shirts to dresses and Sunday best. Wear whatever helps you feel comfortable as we gather to worship our amazing God.



Is there coffee?

Absolutely! Coffee is available before the service, and you're welcome to bring it with you into worship.

What about kids?

Kids are always welcome in worship! During the service we have a brief Children's Moment led by our Children's Minister or one of our volunteers. After that, children are invited to remain in worship with their families or attend our nursery for the rest of the service. A nursery is available for the entire service. We also have a quiet room available for nursing mothers or for children who simply need a sensory break.

How long is the service?

Our worship service lasts about one hour.

Is there Communion, and is it open to everyone?

Holy Communion is usually celebrated on the first Sunday of each month. At St. Matthew's, the Communion table is open to everyone who desires to receive God's grace. During Communion, we also receive a special offering for the John Wesley Fund, which provides assistance to people in our community who are experiencing financial hardship.

Will I know the songs?

Don't worry if you don't know the music. There is no expectation that you already know the songs. All of the lyrics are displayed on the screens so everyone can sing along.

Do I need to bring a Bible?

No. Scripture will be displayed during the message, but we encourage you to bring your Bible and journal if you'd like. Many people also use a Bible app on their smartphone or tablet.

Is the building handicap accessible?

Yes. Our campus is handicap accessible, and accessible parking is available near the entrances.
