This is a quick update for those who may not already follow us on Facebook. On August 5<sup>th</sup>, Sarah gave birth to an 8lb/20 inch baby boy (Caleb Walker Hauth). Caleb was born with a collapsed lung and was quickly taken to the neonatal intensive care unit where he has remained since birth. Additional tests revealed low blood sugar and possible pre-birth trauma due to having his umbilical cord wrapped around his neck. During the past three days, Caleb has also had several episodes where his O<sub>2</sub> levels drop and he appears to stop breathing. We rejoice at the healing that God has already performed on his little body and we expectantly await more good news about the status of his breathing. At the same time, this has been a scary period for Sarah and I. As



first-time parents, we never knew that we could love anybody as much as we love our son. For Sarah, now sick with a cold and unable to visit the hospital (by NICU policy), it has been an especially trying time. Over the past several days, we have received an overwhelming amount of support from friends and family around the world. Our hope and prayer is that we can someday bless all of you in the same way that you continue to bless our family.
