Darrell's Notes

Our Three Pillars sermon series reminded us of how service, both within and outside the church, are an important part of "living sent." Our church is creating two new opportunities for members to serve. First, we are launching a "Senior Friends Ministry" in April. Some senior adults, due to family or personal circumstances, need help attending Sunday School and/or the worship service on Sunday mornings. Sandy Tarpley will be coordinating this new ministry, with guidance from Mary Leigh Coleman, to match seniors with a need for transportation with those members who feel led to befriend them and provide Sunday morning transportation. Priority as riders will be given to seniors with no local family members. Drivers will make a commitment to provide transportation for six months at a time. They will be assigned seniors who live in close proximity to them, if at all possible. This ministry will not serve as a taxi service for purposes other than Sunday morning church attendance. Riders and drivers will be responsible to communicate between themselves when schedules change. Please call Sandy Tarpley at 478-278-0710 during the month of March if you are a senior needing a ride or if you wish to volunteer to be a Senior Friend.

Secondly, our church will resume passing the offering plate during our worship service beginning April 7. While all the existing ways to give in support of our church and its mission will continue (e.g. giving boxes, office drop slot, online giving, etc.), we wish to reincorporate congregational giving as part of our worship experience on Sunday mornings. The request to do this has come from various groups and individuals, including parents who wish their children to learn about giving from their example and senior adults who miss the practice. We will be reorganizing our offering ministry to include more than deacons passing our offering plates. We want any member who wishes to serve in this way to be able to do so, including teenagers and younger children (if accompanied by a parent). If you would be interested in serving, please call Noah at 478-219-7378, so we can begin compiling a list and assigning a rotation.
