
Bear Sunday February 11, 2024

Darrell's Notes

This past Sunday, I presented to our church the *Orange Ball Challenge* in our morning service. For those who were unable to attend, let me explain. Many of our people have filled out a white ping pong ball and placed it in our Acts 1:8 tower. Each one of those 245 white balls represents a commitment made by a member to pray for different individuals whom they are not certain know Christ as

Savior and Lord. These members have committed to pray for the salvation of these individuals, as well as pray for an opportunity to have a Gospel conversation with them.

The Orange Ball Challenge asks those who completed a white ball to take at least one orange ping pong ball from the top step of the sanctuary stage. Those orange balls represent a commitment to seek, to try to have a Gospel conversation sometime over the next four weeks with the person/ persons that ball/balls represent. Participants will place orange balls somewhere they will see them every day as a reminder of their commitment to be willing to share. They will also serve as a prayer prompt. Every day, when they see it, they will take a moment to pray for the person/persons represented, as well as for an opportunity to have a Gospel conversation with them. Please know that it is still not too late for you to choose to participate. Just take an orange ball from the sanctuary stage!

If a member has a Gospel conversation of any kind over the next four weeks, they will make sure to bring back that orange ball to the church, place the initials of the person they shared with on it, and drop that ball into the fishbowl placed on the altar. Every Sunday we will celebrate the orange balls being added to the fishbowl and pray for all those who are still seeking to have a Gospel conversation. At the end of four weeks, we will take time to celebrate, praise God, and pour all of the orange balls into our Acts 1:8 tower. It is a visual representation of our church's commitment to the Great Commission!




