

# Pastor's Notes

GA is susceptible to tornadoes, hurricanes, and freezing rain. It is a priority of this church to communicate well when we are forced by unsafe weather to cancel church activities. Our default position will be to always have church activities unless the weather forces a change. We will announce a decision early enough that members and their families (especially our committed volunteers) can make a timely decision as to their attendance. Our church's priority is you and your family's safety, based on road, parking lot, and sidewalk conditions specifically in the instance of icy weather. When dangerous weather of any kind threatens on a Sunday, we will try to announce a decision by 6 PM and not later than 9 PM on Saturday night. We will do so via email, social media, and our website only. We have created a weather safety group comprised of the church ministry staff and lay leaders (Chairman of Deacons & Safety/Security Director.) This group will make weather related decisions after research and discussion. We encourage members and their families to prioritize their own safety, whether or not the church decides to cancel activities.


## Flowers
