Friendship News.....

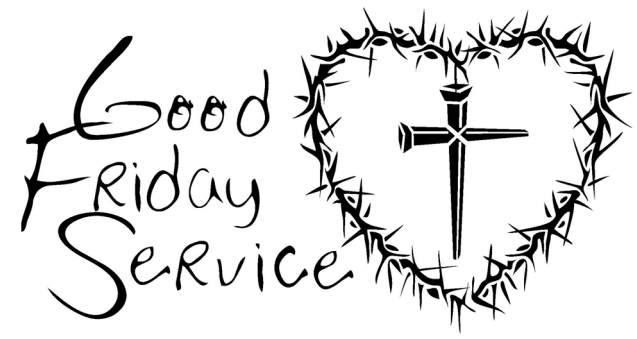

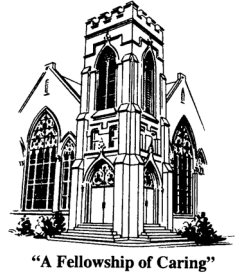
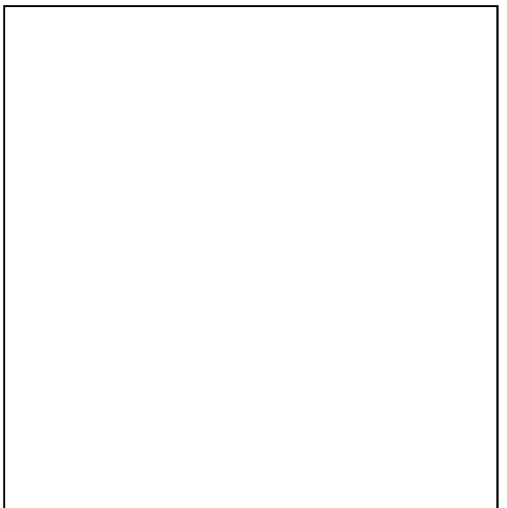
