

Cliff Notes.....

John, having described the crucifixion and resurrection of Jesus, goes on to conclude the Book of John with an account of Jesus’ appearance to His disciples up in Galilee. The disciples would be challenged there to press on in serving the Lord after He would no longer be visibly seen among them. Peter especially had concerns about his own failure under pressure and his denials of Christ while He was on trial. John’s final words show us the full restoration of Peter to service, and that in turn can be an encouraging message to all Christians today. This Sunday we will look at John’s Gospel in both the morning and evening services. God’s grace and Jesus’ ministry of restoration are truly amazing!

Music Notes.....

When our handbell choirs began in February, I received word that they had not been used in quite some time. Upon opening each case, the bells showed that to be true. Handbells, much like any other instrument, need to be cared for and maintained. When left to sit in a case unused, the interior parts begin to rot and break. Since the beginning of our rehearsals, we have had to order replacement parts for three bells. The other 58 bells are also on the verge of breaking and needing replacement parts.

Schulmerich, whose brand of bells we use, offers a refurbishment program. This process completely replaces every part, except for the bell itself. While a new five octave set costs approximately \$30,000, a full refurbishment only costs \$8,500. A full refurbishment of our handbells will ensure their ability to function properly for many years.
