If you are interested in reserving one or more of our facilities, please review the guidelines below and complete the Facility & Bus Request Form linked below. *Please note: the guidelines and request form do not apply to weddings*.

- Facility Usage Request must be made at least two weeks before the event.
- Facility Usage Fees are required at the time of request.
- Facility Usage Fees will be refunded if the request is not approved.
- Cancellation: A full refund will be given if cancellation notice is received 2 weeks before the event. Anything less than 2 weeks' notice, one-half of the payment will be refunded.
- Any damage to equipment or facilities, other than from normal use, shall be the responsibility of those renting the facility.
- Liability: It is an express term of this agreement that the renter will be liable to the Church for any costs or damages of any kind incurred by the Church, as a result of the rental of the facility by the renter.
- Use of any audio, media, or light resources in the Sanctuary, Chapel, or Chapel Commons requires completion of the request and payment of established fees.
- No alcoholic beverages or tobacco products will be allowed on any part of the MZBC Campus.


