

I have absolutely loved preaching about faith over the last couple of months, and I'm encouraged by the responses I've received. Our annual Trunk -N- Treat is right around the corner! This event is typically very large and can draw up to 1,500 people. What would it look like for us to approach this event with strong faith?

This event is not about giving candy to the children of our church. No parent needs the church to provide candy for their children—we know you are more than capable of that without any help from us. It's not even primarily about the games (though I personally love seeing our church come together to fellowship and have fun). Instead, I want to encourage you to think missionally about our Trunk -N- Treat. Everything we do here at Mount Zion Baptist Church must be about the Harvest. This entire effort is about reaching people with the Gospel of Jesus Christ.

During a time when many around the country celebrate darkness, our church will shine the light of Christ into our community. What if our church reached just one family?

Picture this: a young family from a nearby neighborhood attends our event and says to themselves, "Our kids had such a nice time—maybe we should try visiting this church." The next Sunday, they come and engage in our worship service. Their children make friends and have a wonderful experience. Now imagine that one of their family members comes to faith in Christ and is baptized. That same family, over time, begins serving in ministry and missions. Then, they reach out to their friends and neighbors, sharing what God is doing in their lives and inviting others to church. Imagine the glorious ripple effect of reaching just one family! And now imagine not just one, but ten families meaningfully joining our church in this way. This is what God is capable of doing through this one outreach event!

We are going to do everything we can to ensure that this event is missional. Every family that attends Trunk -N-Treat will receive a gospel presentation, a "save the date" card for VBS, and an invitation to our December Christmas events. We will do everything possible to ensure that our community has a wonderful time while on our campus. There are a few things that you can do to help us make this event effective.

Here are three ways you can help us reach people:

- 1. Pray that God would draw the right families to attend.
- 2. Volunteer. Every year, we need people to decorate cars, host games, hand out candy, prepare food, and serve in the welcome tents.
- 3. Invite your friends and neighbors. This is the most effective way for us to reach our community.

Thank you for being part of this mission to shine the light of the Gospel. May the Lord supernaturally use this event to build His kingdom in wonderful ways!
