

Course Title: 3rd-4th Grade English*

Cost: \$400

Description:

Your student will become proficient with their English skills through grammar, vocabulary, literature and writing. Vocabulary will be learned through fun games and activities while also learning early fundamentals of becoming a good writer through short stories using the IEW textbook. We will take adventures in reading four novels this year and discuss each book in class. There will be small, fun writing assignments after finishing each novel.

*The IEW textbook that is required for this class is a continuation of what was used for 3rd/4th English in 2023/2024. Students who took the class during the 23/24 year will not need to purchase a new writing textbook.
