Course Title: Saxon Math

Cost: \$425

Description:

The student can expect to learn arithmetic calculation, measurements, geometry and other skills, an introduction to pre-algebra, ratios, probability and statistics. Students will specifically learn about adding/subtracting/multiplying fractions, equivalent fractions, the metric system, repeating decimals, scientific notation, Pi, graphing inequalities, multiplying algebraic terms, the Pythagorean Theorem, the slope-intercept form of linear equations, and more. Quarterly Zoom calls are available to assist students who may have additional questions or need help with certain concepts.

Daily requirements: 15+ homework problems will be assigned daily with the exception of test days. Approximately 30+ minutes per day can be expected for the student to spend on this math course.

*The advanced 6th grade math student may want to consider this class.

**The struggling 8th grade math student may want to consider this class to solidify concepts.
