- Organize and lead regular choir rehearsals
- Prepare students for performances, concerts, and special events (e.g., Christmas programs, spring concerts, chapel services)
- Coordinate music selections that align with school values and calendar events

- Incorporate biblical principles and Christ-centered values into music instruction
- Select music that supports worship and spiritual development
- Encourage students to use their musical gifts to glorify God

Classroom Management

- Establish a positive, structured, and engaging learning environment
- Maintain appropriate classroom discipline aligned with school policies
