Course Title: Pre-Algebra

Cost: \$455

Description:

This course covers basic rules of solving equations using the associative, commutative, and other properties. Concepts include negative numbers, order of operations, solving for unknowns, and geometry concepts including surface area, volume, and the pythagorean theorem. Math-U-See is structured to master one concept per lesson and tests for mastery each week. In class, I will teach the lesson and have opportunities for group and individual practice. At home, students have access to video instruction online to reinforce lessons taught in class. Practice review games and group projects are implemented throughout the year.

Weekly assignments: Students will complete 3 worksheets for practice and review and 1 test for a weekly grade. Three unit tests are given throughout the year to be completed in class.

Prerequisites: Proficient in math facts 1-12, multiplying and dividing fractions and decimals, and converting fractions and decimals to percentages. [Placement test is available here.](#) Internet access is required to use video instruction.
