Course Title: Pre-Algebra

Cost: \$425

Description:

Algebra 1/2 represents a combination of Pre-Algebra mathematics as well as additional topics from geometry and discrete mathematics. With algebra 1/2 students will deepen their understanding of pre-algebra topics such as fractions, decimals, percents, mixed numbers, signed numbers, order of operations, evaluation of algebraic expressions, and solutions for linear equations in one unknown. Quarterly Zoom calls are available to assist students who may have additional questions or need help with certain concepts.

Daily requirements: 25-30 homework problems will be assigned daily with the exception of test days. Approximately 30+ minutes per day can be expected for the student to spend on this math course.
