Elementary (PreK4-6th)

PreK4/Kindergarten Enrichment: Crayons, scissors, 2 glue sticks, pencils, markers, art supply box, and one 8.5x11 spiral bound sketch book (sketch book can be found for under \$5 at Walmart), watercolor paint, 2 fine tip dry erase markers

Kindergarten-2nd Reading Lab: Small supply box or pouch, pencils, crayons, 2 glue sticks, scissors, and 2 dry erase markers

Kindergarten-2nd S.T.E.M.: Folder, pencils, scissors, clear tape

1st/2nd Math: Glue sticks, markers, pencils, crayons, and scissors

1st/2nd English: Small supply box or pouch, pencils, crayons, 2 glue sticks, scissors, and 2 dry erase markers

1st/2nd History: Glue sticks, markers, pencils, crayons, and scissors

1st/2nd Science: Wide ruled composition notebook, pencils, scissors, 2 glue sticks, crayons and/or colored pencils

3rd/4th US Constitution and History: Crayons, glue, markers, pencils, scissors

3rd-5th Math Lab: 3 ring binder, notebook paper, construction paper, tape, scissors, pencils, markers

3rd-5th S.T.E.M.: 3-ring binder, notebook paper, construction paper, tape, scissors, pencils, pen, markers

5th/6th World History: A small binder or folder specifically for history notes and handouts, highlighters, loose paper, index cards, colored pencils/crayons or markers

5th/6th Science: Colored pencils or markers, scissors, 2 folders, 1 pack 3x5 index cards, pencils

5th/6th Math: Pencils, lined paper, 2 pocket folder, package of fine tip whiteboard markers (4 count)

Middle (7th-8th)

7th/8th English: Binder, loose leaf paper, pencils, pens...REQUIRED LITERATURE BOOKS: *"The Sign of the Beaver"* by Elizabeth George Speare, *"The Best Christmas Pageant Ever"* by Barbara Robinson, *"Someplace to Call Home"* by Sandra Dallas, *"Words on Fire"* by Jennifer A. Nielson

7th/8th World History: Small binder dedicated for this class, highlighters, loose paper, index cards, colored pencils/crayons or markers

7th/8th Science: Pencils, 3x5 cards, 2 folders, colored pencils

7th/8th Math Foundations: Pencil, paper, 1" 3 ring binder, stapler

6th-8th Agriculture:

6th-8th STEM: Folder, pencils, scissors, clear tape

High School (9th-12th)

9th/10th English: Pencils, pens, loose leaf notebook paper or notebook (for note taking, classroom assignments, & homework), access to a computer and printer

Algebra 1: Pencil, paper, 1" 3 ring binder, graph paper, scientific calculator (most cell phones have a scientific calculator), stapler

Algebra 2: Pencil, paper, 1" 3 ring binder, graph paper, scientific calculator (most phones have a scientific calculator), stapler

Biology: Notebook or binder, paper(college or wide ruled), pens, pencils

British Literature: Pencils, pens, loose leaf notebook paper or notebook (for note taking/classroom assignments), access to a computer and printer...REQUIRED LITERATURE BOOKS: *"Macbeth"* by Shakespeare, *"Robinson Crusoe"* by Daniel Defoe, *"Dr Jekyll and Mr. Hyde"* by R.L. Stevenson, *"Frankenstein"* by Mary Shelley

Consumer Math: Basic desk calculator for class daily, paper, and pencils

Chemistry: 1" binder, loose paper, pencils/pens

Composition and Rhetoric: Binder or folder for handouts, looseleaf paper, pencils, pens, computer, & printer

Cosmetology 1: Notebook or binder with paper, pens

Economics: Pens and paper

Forensics: Pencils, lined paper, 2 pocket folder, scissors, a blood typing kit (these can be found at walmart.com or Amazon)

Geometry: Paper, pencil, compass, protractor, ruler, 1" 3 ring binder, stapler

Government: 3 ring notebook for an ongoing project, pens, notebook paper

Personal Finance: Small binder specifically for this class, highlighters, loose paper, index cards, colored pencils/crayons/or markers

Physical Science: Paper, pencils/pens, folder
