Middle (7th-8th)

7th/8th US History and Geography: 3 ring binder (will need a dedicated binder for 2nd semester geography; for first semester a dedicated binder is not necessary. If you choose to use one binder for multiple subjects I recommend pocket/tab dividers to easily organize each subject), notebook paper, highlighters,page protectors, index cards (any size, can use colored cards if desired)

7th/8th Science: pencil, scissors, either a pack of small tip markers or colored pencils, 2 pocket folder **7th/8th Math**: pencil, paper, 1" 3 ring binder

3rd-8th Agriculture: Ream of copy paper, pencils, color pencils, glue, two pocket folder with prongs, scissors

High School (9th-12th)

9th/10th English: Pencils, pens, loose leaf notebook paper or notebook (for note taking, classroom assignments, & homework), access to a computer and printer
