Sin and Atonement

1. Sin is the problem

- Romans 3:23 For <u>all have sinned</u> and fall short of the glory of God
- Romans 6:23a For the wages of sin is death

2. Jesus is the solution

- Romans 5:8 But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that <u>while we were still sinners, Christ</u> died for us
- Romans 10:13 For everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved
