A greater rest awaits those who have faith in Christ

- 1. There <u>remains</u> a greater <u>rest</u> for the people of God (1-5)
 - a. Be sure you will enter that rest through faith
- 2. There is an appointed time to receive this rest (6-11)
 - a. God's "appointed time" is called today
- 3. We will be held accountable for our lives to God (12-13)
 - a. By His word He convicts and calls us
